In England's green and pleasant Land.

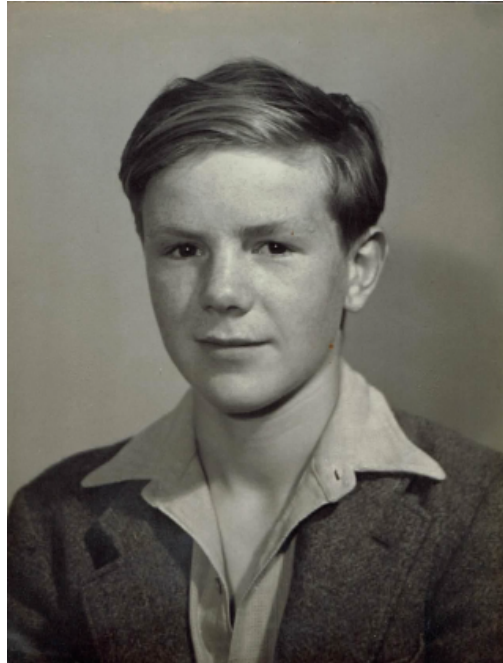
Today

At night, will return.

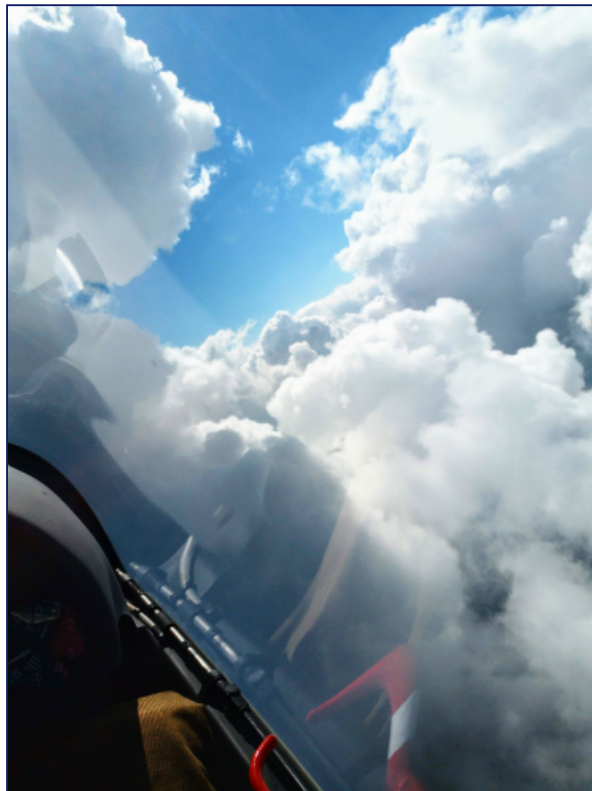
Nicky and Diana were both fond of this poem / hymn as they sang it at their respective schools and felt that it expresses the way they wanted to live their lives
